## **ORDINANCE NO. 82**

An ordinance relating to itinerant peddlers and vendors of medicine.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Haven, Kansas.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for an itinerant vendor of drugs or medicines to vend or peddle the same in the city of Haven, Kansas without first procuring a license so to do, and for which license said vendor or peddler shall pay to the city the sum of ten (\$10.00) dollars per day for each and every day such license shall be in force; provided, that no license shall be issued to any person to vend or peddle drugs or medicines until such person shall have furnished satisfactory proof that he has complied with the pharmacy laws of the state of Kansas.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars or more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and shall be confined in the city jail until such fine and costs are paid.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in effect upon its publication in the Haven Journal.
