- 12. Buildings and Cemetery Maintenance (Todd Bingham) . Council Member Bingham wanted a discussion on the latest information on the wells. The reports and research done for the well have been to given to the State and the State has given them to the concerned citizens. We have found out that those citizens are possibly going to a water attorney and an engineer in Salt Lake. Council Member Spackman is working with Bear River Water Conservancy District as a representative for the town. Sometime in February we will probably have a hearing sponsored by the State for the town and the citizens to present information and then the State will decide what is to be done by both parties. The decisions are up to the State and out of town control ever since the concerned citizens approached the State. Approximately \$12,000 has been spent so far to understand whether harm to anyone by the Deweyville well has been done or may be done .
