11. Deweyville/Elwood Cold Water Spring Renovation—Council Member Bingham questioned why do it in a dry year. It was explained that in a dry year you capture water that is a steady source. Currently, the Division of Wildlife are reviewing the renovation.
12. Fire District Information, Emergency Management—The Fire District is going thru the bylaws, Emergency Management is planting potatoes, and we have laying chickens.

13. Water and Roads (Nathan Spackman)—Council Member Spackman hasn't heard back from the state. We have not used the well in question. Robert Oaks wrote a study on our area. The engineering firm asked him to do the study. Mayor Thayne sent a copy to the Council. We have sent 25 acre feet since we started the agreement with BRAG. We will be asking everyone to conserve water.
14. Documentation, Public Info. Ordinance Enforcement (Eric Anderson) absent Stacy Archuleta presented a report showing the various calls that came in from our town for March and April.
15. Park, Walking Trail, Tree Board P&Z, (Joe Kliger)--Council Member Kliger might want to do a burger night. The Council reviewed fees and scheduling of ball park.
16. Buildings and Cemetery Maintenance (Todd Bingham)—The Cemetery is ready for memorial day.
