6. Fire Station Building for Deweyville--The new county fire warden says there are some avenues for grants. Darrell Anderson Construction is going to estimate a 60 x 72 bldg. We need some planning on the size of the building. The Fire District has to apply and they would own the building. Deweyville will own the land. We need to decide if we want a second floor for meetings. There was a discussion of the costs and availability of grants. There was also a discussion of the costs to residents for fire protection. We need to send out a newsletter asking for public input. For the grant we have 60 days after the application period starts which is any day now. Council Member Andersen will put the grant application together. The Mayor will talk to County Auditor to see what the ramifications would be for taxes.
