9. Park Parking Lot and Cemetery Road Pavement—Council member Bingham is still concerned with the durability of slurry. The backhoe in the cemetery chewed up some of the new pavement. This type of pavement was recommended by the County Road Supervisor. Council member Kliger said that we have three bids to pave the parking lot with the price ranging from \$55,000 to \$75, 000. But we need to have some testing done to know there is a good base. We also need to be ADA compliant by November 1.
