## OPEN BURN REGULATIONS

The state Department of Environmental Quality has issued the dates when open burning is possible this year. They have also made us aware of new regulations which require completion and approval of an on-line permit application for anyone wanting to open-burn for any reason. The dates for open burn this spring in Utah County is from March 30th through May 30<sup>th</sup>. There will also be a fall open burning period. Open burning is considered daily by the DEQ and is allowed only if the "Clearing Index" is high enough to allow it. Completed and approved permits must be on-site with the responsible person at the location of the open burn.
