

CITY COUNCIL MEMBER APPOINTMENT

The Lindon City Mayor and City Council will accept applications to fill the remaining two-year term of a City Council at-large vacancy left open because Council member Jeff Acerson has been elected as the new Mayor. This term of office will continue until 12:00 noon on the first Monday in January, 2016. Those interested in being appointed to fill this vacancy must meet the requirements and submit a complete application signed in the presence of the Lindon City Recorder no later than Monday, January 27, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. Applicants for office will be interviewed by the Mayor and Council in a regularly scheduled City Council meeting to be held at 7:00 p.m. on February 4, 2014 and/or February 18, 2014 at the City Center. The Mayor and Council will then select an applicant to fill the vacancy. Applications will be available at the City Center, and on the city website beginning January 8, 2014.
