GARBAGE & RECYCLING FEE CHANGES

Lindon City is proposing the following rate changes in monthly garbage and recycling fees in order to cover costs of providing the waste removal services to residents:

Service	2012-2013 Rates	Proposed 2013-2014 Rates	Change
Garbage – 1 st can	\$9.58	\$9.90	\$0.32
Garbage – Each additional can	\$4.94	\$7.32	\$2.38
Recycling – Each can	\$4.79	\$4.13	(\$0.66)

Due to the increase in costs to remove waste in additional garbage cans we strongly encourage those with multiple garbage cans to replace their additional cans with recycling cans in order to decrease household expenses. Recycling cans cost less! Ordering recycling cans or replacing your second garbage can with a recycling can is accomplished by calling our Utility Clerk at 801-785-5043 or by stopping by the Lindon City Center front desk. No sorting or cleaning of materials is needed to recycle paper, plastic, metals, or cardboard...just throw it all in! NOTICE TO LINDON CITY UTILITY CUSTOMERS

In compliance with State law, Lindon City is disclosing proposed transfer of funds from the utility enterprise funds to the general fund for use in providing such city services as fire, police, administration, recreation, and other functions. Proposed amounts transferred to the general fund are as follows: Solid Waste Collection Fund \$15,532; Sewer Fund \$275,870; Water Fund \$296,466; and Storm Water Drainage System Fund \$142,621. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 18, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the Lindon City Center located at 100 North State Street, Lindon, Utah regarding the adoption of the Lindon City budget for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2013 and ending on June 30, 2014.
