Committee Meeting Minutes - October 16, 2012

The Lindon City Historic Preservation Commission held a regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, October 16, 2012 at the Lindon City Office Building.

The Meeting Was Called To Order: At 6:05 p.m.

Review and Approval of Minutes: From the September 18, 2012 meeting.

CURRENT BUSINESS –

- 1) **TITHING HOUSE:** Committee discussion about the Tithing house and property.
 - We would like to have the opportunity to look over the property, particularly the basement and outside grounds, to see if we can find any artifacts relevant to the history of Lindon City. If any artifacts are found, we would like to consider putting them on display in the Lindon City Community Center. We would also like to contact the BYU Archaeology department and ask for any suggestions they might have in regards to old properties.

IT IS OUR RECOMMENDATION THAT THE TITHING HOUSE BE PUT UP FOR SALE IN SIXTY DAYS.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY CONNIE LAMOREAUX AND SECONDED BY JUNE SMITH. ALL MEMBERS PRESENT VOTED IN FAVOR OF THIS MOTION.

- 2) **NOTE CARD STATIONERY:** Tonya LaMone was able to get stationery printed with the Lindon City Historic Preservation Commission logo. This stationery can be used to write thank you notes, etc., and is available for the commission members to use as needed.
- 3) **ORAL HISTORIES:** There is ongoing work with the oral histories.

- Connie L. reported that Sister Walker's daughter will help.
- Steve A. mentioned that we have some recorded histories that need to be transcribed, read and edited to turn them into a storylines; a recollection and presentation of the interviewees' memories.
- Lyle L. recommended taking the 8mm files that he has to Allen's Camera. Brother Winterton will work with us to organize the film clips of how Lindon used to be. It is suggested we print still photos, make DVDs, and set them up with a narrative.
- Lyle L. also spoke with Marva Johnson regarding audio tapes. (These are old tapes with interviews of High Priests back when only two wards existed in Lindon. It is important that we be very careful with these tapes and respectful of the sensitive information on them.
- Betsy M. wondered if we should have some type of permission slips stating authorization from the families for us to work with the old tapes. The committee did not think that permission slips were necessary at this time.

4) **CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING:** It is important that the Historic committee members be visible during this event since it is historic in nature.

- Historic Committee and Senior Center are working with Mr. Bateman who is over the Lindon City Parks and Recreation events, and his assistant, Hannah, in planning for the Tree Lighting Ceremony that will be held on **Monday, December 2, 2012**. Following are the assignments made for the Tree Lighting Ceremony:
 - Pastor Mike to say prayer
 - Historical Commission to provide candy canes (June Smith volunteered to get the candy canes)
 - Rocky Mountain Elementary School will provide music
 - Brother Fugal to share a scripture
 - Seniors to provide Santa and crafts for children inside the Center.
 - Steve Anderson to share history of Lindon Tree Lighting (Tonya LaMone will send the history information to Steve Anderson)
 - Brother Bateman to be Master of Ceremony
 - Police will be asked to... (?)

THE SENIOR CENTER HAS ASKED THAT WE HELP THEM FINANCIALLY WITH THE LIGHTING MATERIALS (LIGHTS). WE ARE WILLING TO PROVIDE UP TO \$200.00 FROM OUR BUDGET TO HELP SUPPORT THEM WITH THIS.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY TONYA L. AND SECONDED BY JUNE S. ALL MEMBERS PRESENT VOTED IN FAVOR OF THIS MOTION.

5) **COMMUNITY CENTER ROOMS FOR HISTORICAL COMMISSION USE:**

- Lyle L. will gather information on the possibility of removing the wall between the two small Community Center rooms. Removal of this specific wall would open up the room space giving us a larger area in which to display historic Lindon items and artifacts. Lyle will report his findings to Tonya L.

- We are also hoping to locate some donated or low cost antique furniture to place in this room. If private parties or local companies donate anything for this use we can display their name/s next to the item/s.
 - It was suggested that we contact Maxine Radmall of Rosebud Antiques, who may have some available furniture for this purpose.
- 6) **NEW HISTORIC PROPERTY MARKERS:** Three of five markers are left to complete.
- Lyle L. is working on the Bowman home.
 - Steve A. has Banks and Community Center completed.
- 7) **EVALUATION FORM:** Huck Finn evaluation was passed around and additional comments were noted.
- Betsy will make a copy of this evaluation to pass on to the city group who will be in charge of this event in the future.
- 8) **BUDGET REPORT:** We need to have a current copy of the budget at each committee meeting.
- Betsy will check on this.
- 9) **THANKSGIVING DINNER 2012 AT THE LINDON COMMUNITY CENTER:**
