## VINEYARD CONNECTOR UPDATE

Beginning Monday, September 10, 2012, 2000 West at 200 North, Lindon, will close for two weeks while construction crews install a pipeline for the North Shore Aqueduct of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District Water Development Project. The 2 week closure will require a detour for those who wish to access the Transfer Station, Animal Shelter, and the Lindon Boat Harbor as well as area businesses from the Pleasant Grove 1-15 exit. 2000 West will be closed in both the south and north directions along with 200 North. ## PRESCRIPTION TAKE BACK EVENT
