Residents of Lindon City are served by our own Lindon City Police Department. Chief Cody Cullimore, Sergeant Doug Eastman, Sergeant Josh Edwards, and officers David Welcker, Marc Wright, Steve Gray, John Lloyd, Matt Barlow, Curtis Campbell, Ray Ormond, Tony Weinmuller, Alan Purvis, Eric Whitehead, Jake Simmons, and Josh Boren, along with Robyn Clark as the Departments Administrative Professional and Julie Sutch and Mindy Zobell as Receptionists/Records Clerks. The Lindon City Police Department began serving Lindon residents full time in July of 2008.

Full time Fire and EMS service from the Lindon Fire Station, located just east of the City Center, also began on July 1, 2008. Personnel of the Orem Department of Public Safety provide full time response to Lindon residents from our own fire facilities. The Firefighter/Paramedics responding from the Lindon fire station are highly trained professionals, with Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) capabilities. Three crews of firefighters are assigned full time to work from the Lindon station. The Public Works Department manages and maintains over 50 miles of roads within the City, including snow removal. Public Works also manages and maintains the culinary and secondary water system, and works in cooperation with Orem City to maintain the sewer system, which runs to the Orem City Waste Water Treatment Plant. Public Works staff also manages the City's excellent storm drainage system, which continues to be improved as funding is available. The Public Works Director is also the cemetery sexton. Cemetery plots can be purchased and burial arrangements made by contacting the Public Works Department. Engineering functions are provided through a contract with JUB Engineers.
