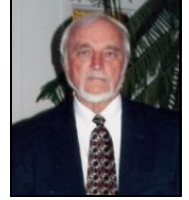

### Message from the Mayor



Council and Planning had one meeting in May due to the proximity of Memorial Day and members traveling. The last meeting in May was cancelled. Council passed the development agreement for Edgehill Drive Estates, an 8 lot subdivision generally at 300 Edgehill Drive. Council determined that a \$2500 fee could be substituted for each share of water required. The Council also amended the Personnel Policy in favor of employees concerning earned hours and also relative to retirement hours banked. Council also passed a resolution agreeing to establish a Regional Sewer Treatment Committee relative to Logan's proposal for a new sewer treatment facility. This resolution is before all cities presently using Logan's facility. It needs to be noted that even though this proposed committee is "advisory" only, we will be interfacing with Logan for several years while the South is pursuing other options. A request for proposal (RFP) has been finalized by Providence, Nibley, and Hyrum to establish a Southern sewer district and is presently out for bid. The results of this study will finalize either our attachment to Logan or our separation with the feasibility of Hyrum's present facility being modernized and expanded to handle the geographical South area of the valley. We also had discussions on the budget for all Providence City funds for FY ending 6/30/15. There are presently no rate increases or property tax increases.

The city also heard an appeal (Appeals Board) concerning business licenses which will be decided by the end of June.

Planning, besides approving past minutes, continued their discussion of Sign Regulations. They also reviewed items relative to planning from the Utah League of Cities and Towns Powers and Duties Handbook.

Keep in mind the City Celebration on June 7. I hope to see you all there for a great time.
