City Code Reminders:

• **Private Signs and Handbills:**

- Please remember, private signs are not allowed on public property. This includes the park strip area between the sidewalk and curb.
- Private handbills should not be posted on any sidewalk, curb, or any other portion or part of any public way or public place, or any lamp post, electrical light, telephone pole, etc., or public structure or building.

• **Ditches:**

- Owners or occupants of property having ditches running in front of their lots between the street and sidewalks are required to maintain and keep the ditches clean.
- Irrigation water should not be allowed to flow on the streets or sidewalks.
