## The Sauerkraut Project

- On August 24th and September 7th, a crew of Providence volunteers shredded, salted and tamped cabbage in food-grade barrels for fermentation in to sauerkraut. Six 40-gallon barrels were produced, with one barrel reserved for the dinner and the rest to be canned.

Our sauerkraut is now resting (working) comfortably at Zollinger's in storage, awaiting canning. We had one grower who had a germination problem with his seed, so we only had about half the cabbage available for sauerkraut that we originally expected.

We expect demand to be high as we have had many inquiries as to when the canned sauerkraut will be available. And with limited supply, we may run out early.
