## **Substance Abuse Policy**

## **Drugs and Alcohol**

Employees involved in any unauthorized use, possession, transfer, sale, manufacture, distribution, purchase, or presence of drugs/alcohol or drug paraphernalia on the Town of Randolph's property or having reported to work with detectable levels of illegal drug or alcohol will be subject disciplinary action, including termination.

## Definition of terms in policy:

- a. Drug paraphernalia: Objects used to manufacture, compound, convert, produce, prepare, test, analyze, pack, re-pack, store, contain, conceal drugs or inject, ingest, inhale, or otherwise introduce a drug to the human body.
- b. Drugs Unauthorized/Illegal): Narcotics, marijuana, hashish, cocaine, alcohol, and controlled substances or medications other than those sold to the public on a nonprescription basis or those prescribed to an employee by a duly licensed physician.
- c. Prescription Drugs: Those medications (containing drugs or other controlled substances) that are prescribed to and individual by an authorized physician, carried in its original container that is labeled by a licensed pharmacist, and taken as directed.
