To Whom It May Concern:

Referencing the proposed landfill in Hansel Valley, we as Snowville Water Company would like to **OPPOSE** this action and do hereby make formal notice to the Box Elder County Commissioners and the Box Elder Planning and Zoning Committee.

The rural community of Snowville currently has 110 residential and commercial water connections - water IS the life blood of Snowville Town. We get our water from two deep culinary wells and a spring in the area which is located within 4 miles of the proposed site and within ranges of our source protection. If such a landfill were to come into our area, there is a great probability of contamination to our water sources at some point, now or in the future. The proposed landfill site sits on a natural fault line, and no one can guarantee there will not be problems with that ground, we feel it is not worth the risk. It is a threat to our existence here.

The proposed landfill is of virtually no benefit to the citizens of Box Elder County. The project threatens all we hold dear as citizens of the county and in particular those surrounding areas directly affected.

We ask you to consider the value of our communities water and land for not just our use but for future generations. Poor use of natural resources such as this would impact our area negatively indefinitely.
