

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING OUTDOOR WATERING RESTRICTIONS IN THE  
TOWN OF HOT SULPHUR SPRINGS, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, the construction of the clear well has not been completed the town is still under the enforcement order issued by the CDPHE last summer; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain water supply for all customers in the town; and


WHEREAS, conservation of water is of great importance especially during the course of improvements to our water system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOT SULPHUR SPRINGS, COLORADO THAT the following watering restrictions be approved and become effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 until September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009:

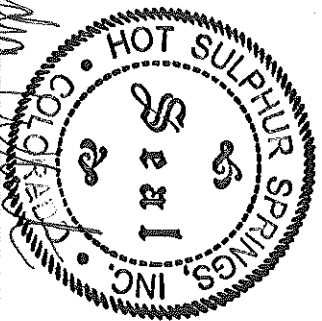
1. Residents of town may use treated town water to irrigate lawns, trees, shrubs, and other outdoor uses every third day between the hours of 6 PM and 9 AM.
2. Conservation techniques are recommended by the use of xeriscaping, drip hoses, timers, and shut off nozzles.
3. Watering will only be allowed on your groups designated days.
4. Town will be divided into three sections those property addresses ending 0-3 start June 1<sup>st</sup>, addresses ending 4-6 start June 2<sup>nd</sup>, and addresses ending 7-9 start June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
5. Water wasting (water that runs off your property) is not allowed.
6. Fines  
Town will set the following penalties for watering outside of the defined restrictions.  
First - Warning  
Second - \$25 fine  
Third - \$50 fine  
Fourth - \$100 fine
7. Property owners that have access to non-treated raw water sources please post in public view.
