SPOTTED FAIR ISLE MITTENS —

Have you seen the mittens on the front of the <u>60 Quick Knits</u> book from Cascade Yarns? Here's your chance to learn a new skill or get a refresher by making this gorgeous spotted fair isle

pair. You will learn the magic loop method for circular knitting and techniques for fair isle knitting (stranding two colors). We will take three consecutive weeks to complete one mitten as you learn these new techniques. You will complete the second mitten on your own.

After completing this course, you will be able to use these three skills for almost any sock design you desire.
