My Bernina Serger Classes

My **Bernina Serger Workbooks** are used as a guide for all classes. When you purchase and pick up your serger at the Bernina Connection you will download a free Serger Workbook from our web site,

www.berninaconnection.com/machine-mastery.htm.

You are responsible for printing out the appropriate workbook prior to class and bringing it with you to class. It is suggested that you punch holes in the Serger Workbook and place it into a three ring binder for ease of use.

For every class you will need to bring your serger, all of its accessories, the appropriate Serger Workbook and the materials listed below.

#1 Basic Serger Use*: (all Bernina sergers except 009)

Kit Fee: \$5.00

Designed to make you comfortable with your new serger, this class covers threading, tension settings, and basic serger applications.

- 4 spools of Serger thread each a different contrasting color – it is best if the colors are not close in value so you can tell them apart after serging. (we recommend A-1 thread carried at the Bernina Connection)
- One cone of Woolly Nylon thread

#2 Serging Ahead*: (all Bernina sergers)

Kit Fee: \$5.00

NOTE: The last half of class is for 1300MDC and 009 models only

This class explores the use of serger accessory presser feet and attachments for both embellishment and practical uses. You'll also discover how to incorporate chain and cover stitching if your model offers these features.

- 4 spools of Serger thread each a different contrasting color – it is best if the colors are not close in value so you can tell them apart after serging. (we recommend A-1 thread carried at the Bernina Connection)
- Two cones of Woolly Nylon
- Glue Stick
- One spool decorative thread like Razzle Dazzle, Pearl Crown Rayon or Jeans Stitch thread.

***Note: Some exercises apply only to models equipped with the highlighted feature.**

Please arrive early enough to set up your machine before class begins. Be sure to check in at the counter to get your name tag and kit. Classes are small, so please register early and cancel at least 24 hours in advance, if necessary.

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
