Giggle & Squeek Quilt with Carrie Bloomston

Required Pattern: Giggle & Squeek Quilt by SUCH Designs

Fabric needed:

- 9 different or repeating fat quarters for the backgrounds
- A total of 10-12 different fat quarters for heads plus scraps for facial features
- 1/2 yd. cotton fabric for binding
- 47" x 47" cotton fabric for backing
- 46" x 46" (low loft) batting
- 3 yards fusible web (such as Steam-A-Seam lite)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine (with power cord and foot control) cleaned, in good working order with a new needle. If you have a machine other than a Bernina be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book
- Basic sewing kit to include: scissors, straight glass head pins (not plastic), vanishing fabric marker or chalk pencil, etc.
- Rotary cutter, mat and clear grid ruler
- Thread in complimentary colors
- Teflon pressing sheet—**A MUST HAVE**
 - Freezer paper or tracing paper
 - Embroidery floss (optional)

Pre-class Preparation:

- * Read all instructions before beginning
- * All fabrics should be washed, dried, and ironed before beginning
- * Cut at least 3 of the 15" x 15" blocks from the background fabrics
- * Trace all templates for 3 of the critters you want to create onto fusible web (paper side). **NOTE:** *templates are already reversed and ready to trace onto fusible web*

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
