Fabric needed:

- 18" x 10" sky fabric (batiks or hand dyes are fun here)
- 18" x 7 1/2" ground fabric
- Variety of fabrics for greenery, cottage, fence and walkway
- 1 yard Wonder Under #805 fusible web
- 20" x 20" piece of batting
- A piece of one sided fusible Peltex the size of chosen project

Bring to class:

- Basic sewing kit: including straight glass head pins (not plastic), thread clips, scissors, paper scissors sharpie ultra fine point marker,.
- Rotary cutter, cutting mat and acrylic ruler
- Appliqué Pressing Cloth -A Must as we are working with fusible web
- A personal iron and ironing mat would be helpful
- Variety of pearl cotton thread and cotton embroidery floss in a variety of colors for embellishment. We will make a stitch sampler that you can use as a reference
- Embroidery needles sized for embellishment threads (size 3-5, hand needle)

Pre class preparation:

- * Pre wash fabrics (do not use fabric softener)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
