Pocket on a String (P.O.S.)

Tuition: \$25.00

Fabric needed:

- 53” of 1/2” wide nylon webbing
- 3/4 yard, medium/heavy weight fabric, any width, for exterior
- 3/4 yard, light/medium weight fabric, any width, for lining

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine in good working condition with power cord, foot control, slide on tray, with a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina. Extra machine needles
- Edge stitch foot (Bernina #10, Zipper foot, Straight stitch foot (Bernina #13 or #37)
- Basic sewing kit to include: Scissors for thread cutting and sewing shears for cutting fabric, chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing, and topstitching needle for finishing.
- Thread to match fabric
- 12” Zipper

Pre class preparation:

Cut out pieces per pattern instructions:

- * 2 - 10” x 11” square of exterior fabric
- * 2 - 10” x 11” square of lining fabric

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
