## Button Madness: Bracelet *with Mary Furniss*

**Required Pattern:** Teresa Field' Button Madness! By JWD Publishing, LLC

### Fabric needed:

- 3/4" to 1" wide, non-roll elastic w : wrist measurement plus 1/2"
- 3/4" to 1" wide strip of fabric for bracelet backing same length as elastic (use pinking shear for a nice finished look that won't fray)
- 2 3/4" to 1" wide Steam a Seam (the size should match elastic)
- Several assorted flat buttons of various sizes
- Several assorted theme related novelty buttons (including flat backs)
- Small piece of 1/8" wide elastic in coordinating color
- Assorted beads (optional)
- Craft Adhesive for securing flat backs and beads

### Bring to class:

- Needle & thread for sewing on buttons
- Foot #18 can be used to sew on the first level of buttons (optional)
- Fabric scissors; thread scissors
- Iron
- Fluffy towel (optional—one will be available in class to use)
- Applique pressing sheet (optional)

**By the Way:** It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
