Required Book: Everyday Living: Make It & Sell It by Cindy Taylor Oates

Fabric needed:

- 5/8 yard of good quality fabric prewashed and ironed for main fabric
- 1/2 yard of good quality fabric prewashed and ironed for contrast fabric
- 1 1/2 yards of coordinating rick rack
- 1/8 yard of light weight fusible interfacing

Bring to class:

- Sewing Machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with new needle and an empty bobbin
- #10 foot or edge stitch foot and # 1 all purpose foot
- Basic Sewing Kit to include: Pins, fabric chalk marker, 6” ruler, scissors for clipping threads, good fabric scissors, and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Good quality thread to match (consider Aurifil variegated thread)
- Dritz Wash Away Wonder Tape
- #Optional: Fasturn single 3/4” Tool and fabric weights

Pre class preparation:

- * Prepare your pattern pieces by tracing on freezer paper. Trace the pocket as one whole piece NOT on the fold because you will cut two pocket pieces. We will NOT use the pocket interfacing. Trace the apron body piece as to be cut on the fold. Trace the apron interfacing pattern piece then trace another for the fusible interfacing that is 1/4” shorter
- * Prewash and iron your fabrics and rick but DO NOT CUT YOUR FABRIC BEFORE COMING TO CLASS

This is a perfect project for beginning sewers. You are expected to know the basics of how your sewing machine works. A machine with multiple needle positions is preferable.

Bring your favorite apron and apron memory to share

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
