## Jack and Jill Hat with Tracy Lemieux-Bartz

**Required Pattern: Jack and Jill Hat** by Izzy and Ivy Designs

### Fabric needed:

- For hat view A
  - ◇ 1 fat quarter for main body and brim (fabric A)
  - ◇ 1/3 yard fabric for band and lining (fabric B)
  - ◇ 1/8 yard fabric for ruffle (optional)
  - ◇ 2/3 yard fusible interfacing (SF101)
  - ◇ 1/4 yard fusible fleece
- For hat view B
  - ◇ 1/2 yard fabric for main body and brim (fabric A)
  - ◇ 1 fat quarter for lining
  - ◇ 2/3 yard fusible interfacing (SF101)
  - ◇ 1/4 yard fusible fleece

### Bring to class:

- Basic sewing kit including straight glass head pins (not plastic), needles, scissors, seam ripper, water soluble marking pen
- Sewing machine in good working order with a new needle, its power cord and foot pedal
- Thread to match fabric
- Notions: 4" of 1/2" wide elastic; button cover kit (optional); safety pin for pulling elastic through; clip for attaching embellishment

### Pre-class preparation:

- \* Determine what size hat you are making—measure child's head over ears and add 1" — consult chart to determine size needed
- \* Trace pattern pieces on tracing paper

**By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.**



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
