Sew Sweet Dresden Pillow with Tracy Lemieux-Bartz

Required Pattern: Sew Sweet Pillow by Better Homes & Gardens Special Interest
Publication: All small wall hangings, Table runners, Baby Quilts &
Other Little Treasures, 2012, page 93

Fabric needed:

- 5/8 yard fabric for applique foundation (pillow front)
- 1/3 yard fabric total of assorted prints or 24—2 1/2" x 7" strips for outer petals
- 1/4 yard fabric for one color of inner petals or 8—2 1/2" x 7" strips
- 1/4 yard fabric for second color of inner petals or 8—2 1/2" x 7" strips
- Scrap of fabric for center appliqued circle 5" x 5"
- 2/3 yard fabric for pillow back
- 1/4 yard fabric for binding
- 21" square muslin or desired fabric for lining
- 21" square batting
- 18" square pillow form

Bring to class:

- Sewing Machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with new needle
- Basic Sewing Kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, straight glass head pins (not plastic), scissors for clipping threads, shears, seam ripper, etc.
- Thread to match fabrics
- Plastic template

Pre class preparation:

- * Trace pattern pieces A & B onto plastic template (pattern pieces are on page 119)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
