## The Tuffet with Sandee Streech

**Required Pattern:** The Tuffet by Myra Mitchell

### Fabric needed:

- 1/8 yard of 15 to 20 fabrics, or equivalent. Could be 64 different
- 6" square of coordinating fabric
- 5/8 yard of coordinating fabric
- 2 yards of 12 ounce upholstery batting\*
- 2 yards muslin

### Bring to class:

- Sewing machine in good working order with a new needle, its power cord and foot pedal
- Basic sewing kit including pins, needles, scissors, seam ripper, pencil
- Rotary cutter, rulers and mat
- Freezer paper
- 2 1/2" button, covered or otherwise
- 3/4" plywood 18" round board (no particle board, must be plywood)\*\*
- 6" X 18" round of camping/upholstery foam rubber (can be 2—3" pieces)\*
- Upholstery spray adhesive\*
- Upholstery thread\*
- 12" upholstery needle\*
- 4 bun feet or wooden legs, primed and painted or stained\*
- 4 tee nuts 5/16" X 1/2"\*
- 4 hanger bolts 5/16" 2 1/2"\*
- Staple gun and staples
- Optional: Beads, trim soutache braid, piping or ruffles
