Machine Appliqué ABC's with Mary Lewkowitz

Tuition: \$30.00

Fabric needed:

- ½ yard background fabric
- 5 or 6 fat quarters or scraps in contrasting/coordinating colors
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Spray starch (Best Press recommended)
- 1 yard lightweight **fusible web** (BC carries Steam-A-Seam Lite)
- 1/2 yard freezer paper

DO NOT bring fusible interfacing (the kind used in clothing)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with new needle. Machine must be able to do satin stitch and blanket stitch
- Open-toe presser foot (Bernina foot #20)
- Threads that match the above fabrics (I love King Tut, Rainbows, or Isacord)
- Magnifying glass to attach to the machine (optional)
- Basic Sewing Kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, small curved scissors for clipping threads, shears, and seam ripper
- Appliqué pressing cloth
- 505 temporary spray adhesive
- Hand sewing needle
- Roxanne Glue-Baste-It (available at the Bernina Connection)
- Small paint brush or Q-Tips

This is a technique class where you will learn several applique methods.

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
