**Resource Book: Snow Crazy for Machine Embroidery** by Turnberry Lane

### **Fabric needed:**

- 1 yard white fabric for embroidery
- 2/3 yard fabric for inner border (includes extra for crazy patches)
- 1 yard fabric for outer border (included extra for crazy patches)
- 8 various red fat quarters for crazy patches
- 1 yard muslin for crazy patch bases
- 3 yards fabric for backing
- 1/2 yard fabric for binding
- 50” - 60” batting
- 10—11” squares of fusible fleece

### **Bring to class:**

- Embroidery machine/module and embroidery bobbin case cleaned, in good working condition with power cord, foot control, with a new Organ sharp #80 embroidery needles (for embroidery)
- Basic sewing kit including straight glass head pins (not plastic), needles, scissors, seam ripper, pencil
- Rotary cutter, rulers and mat
- Tear away stabilizer
- 505 temporary spray adhesive
- Red machine embroidery thread

**By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.**



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
