Mini Twisted Christmas Wall Hanging

Required Pattern: Twisted Christmas Wall Hanging by The Gathering Room Quilt Shop

Fabric needed:

- Fat quarter of red,
- Fat quarter of green
- Fat quarter of backing fabric
- 1/2 yard fabric for background

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine cleaned, in good working condition with power cord, foot control, with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: dressmaker scissors, straight pins (fine, sharp straight pins with glass head – no plastic head please), seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat and ruler
- Thread to blend with all fabrics
- Template: provided for in-class use. Students may wish to special order one of three sizes
 - ◇ 6” block—Use Itty Bitty Primitive Pinwheels by Primate Gatherings (template size 1 1/2” square)
 - ◇ 10” block—Use Primitive Pinwheels by Primate Gatherings (template size 2 1/4” square)
 - ◇ 18” block—Use Lil’ Twister by CS Designs (template size 3 1/4” square)

Pre class preparation:

- * Purchase fabric and have it washed and ironed and ready for cutting

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
