Fabric needed: Finished pillow sleeve front 10 ½" x 12 ½"

- ½ yard fabric for the background (small print or tone on tone) per Pillow Sleeve
- ½ yard fabric for border & lining per Pillow Sleeve (colorful and striking)
- ½ yard fusible fleece

Bring to Class:

- Sewing/Embroidery machine in good working order with all its accessories and cords
- **Embroidery Supply List:**
 - ◆ Each pillow slip is created for a 5" x 7" hoop, 6" x 10" hoop, & 10" x 14" hoop Note: Designs with a border are only for the hoop size 10" x 14"
 - ◆ Heavyweight Tear Away
 - ◆ 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray
 - ◆ Basic embroidery kit including small doubled curved scissors, long straight pointy tweezers, removable fabric marking pen, etc.
 - ◆ Organ Embroidery Needles #80 Sharps
 - ◆ 40wt. embroidery thread: Each pillow slip uses 4 thread colors that coordinate with the border print
 - ◆ The Bottom Line by Superior Threads (bobbin thread) matching the top thread colors
- **Sewing Supply List**
 - ◆ 50wt. cotton thread neutral color for piecing
 - ◆ Basic sewing kit including straight glass head pins (not plastic), rotary cutter & mat, and a long straight ruler
 - ◆ Mary Ellen's Best Press Starch
 - ◆ 20 ½" square ruler for squaring blocks
- **Pillow**
 - ◆ Bring a neutral or solid colored rectangle pillow 13" x 20" or close to that size
 - ◆ The circumference of the pillow should measure between 22" -29"
 - ◆ (Measure pillow from top around to the bottom and back up to the top, not side to side)
 - ◆ The front of the Pillow Sleeve measures 10 ½" wide by 12 ½" high
- **To make your own Pillow:**
 - ◆ ¾ yard Solid or tone on tone fabric for outside of pillow
 - ◆ ¾ yard Muslin
 - ◆ 12" nylon zipper matching color of fabric
 - ◆ 1 Bag of pillow stuffing

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
