### Bring to each class:

- Sewing machine in good working order with foot control, power cord, its accessories and a new needle or reserve a machine for rental at Bernina Connection
- You should be familiar with your machine prior to class.
- Bring your sewing machine instruction manual
- Basic sewing supplies to include: fabric marking pen, seam gauge, straight glass head pins (not plastic), fabric scissors, and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter, 6 1/2" x 24" ruler and cutting mat
- Thread to match chosen fabrics
- Iron and ironing pad (optional but helpful)

### Fabric needed:

- Use only cotton material for the following lessons. We will discuss the next project scheduled at each class. Please feel free to ask questions prior to class.
- **June 11, OR September 10: Camelback Carry All Pattern**  
Bring your sewing machine with all feet and machine manual. We will discuss sewing tools at this class.  
**Bring glass head pins, seam gauge, pincushion, a fabric marking pen, and fabric scissors**  
**Be sure all your items are clearly labeled with either name or initials**  
2 fat quarters of coordinating fabric (outer fabric and lining fabric)-Fat Quarter size is 18" x 22"  
Coordinating/contrasting thread  
1/2 yard of medium-weight fusible fleece  
14" nylon coil zipper in color that coordinates with fabric  
6" piece of 1/2" or 3/4" wide grosgrain or satin ribbon in a coordinating color  
1/2 yard ShirTailor fusible interfacing

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**By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.**



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.

- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

  - 5/8 yard of cotton floral print fabric
  - 3/4 yard of solid cotton fabric to coordinate with floral center and use as a backing
  - 1/4 yard ShirTailor fusible interfacing
  - 16" pillow form
  - 3 buttons-**less than 1" in diameter**
- **July 9, OR October 8: Handy no-frills Apron**-page 198
  - 1 1/8 yard of cotton fabric for apron
  - 1/2 yard of 45" wide cotton fabric for pocket
  - 1/2 yard fabric for bias trim
  - Swedish Tracing Pattern paper for tracing pattern
  - 1" Bias Tape Maker
  - 2 buttons (optional)
- **July 23 OR October 15: Yoga Pants** page 120 OR **Boxers** - page 134\* *No Knits Please*
  - Boxers:**
    - 1" elastic S (M,L) 1 (1 1/8, 1 1/4) yards
    - 1 3/8 yard cotton woven fabric for all sizes
    - Thread to match
    - OR--
  - Yoga Pants:**
    - 2 5/8 yard of 45" wide cotton fabric
    - 5/8" wide grosgrain ribbon - 1 1/2 yard length
    - Thread to match
- **August 20, OR October 29: Flouncy Tank Top** page 139 OR **Tokyo Tie Bag**
  - Flouncy Tank Top**
    - 1 3/4 yards of 45" cotton fabric
    - Pattern Paper
    - Thread to match
    - 1/2" to 5/8" button
  - Tokyo Tie Bag** - page 170
    - 3/4 yard cotton fabric for outer fabric
    - 3/4 cotton fabric for lining
    - Thread to match
    - 1 1/2 yards ShirTailor fusible interfacing
- **August 27, OR November 12: Naughty Secretary Skirt** page 146
  - Small needs 1 1/4 yard cotton fabric
  - Medium to Large needs 1 7/8 yard of cotton fabric
  - 7" invisible zipper
  - Thread to match
  - 1 package double fold bias tape or 1/2 yard fabric to make your own bias tape
