Fabric needed:

- Fabric A - 1 1/2 yards of fabric
- Fabric B - 1/3 yard of fabric
- Fabric C - 1/3 yard of fabric
- Fabric D - 1/3 yard of fabric
- Fabric E - 1/3 yard of fabric
- Fabric F - 1/8 yard of fabric
- Fabric G - 3/8 yard of fabric
- 55 - 60" square batting
- 60" square backing
- Scraps for quilt label

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord, presser foot, in good working order with a new needle. Machine must have a movable needle option
- Basic sewing kit: including straight glass head pins (not plastic), scissors, water soluble marking pen, long hand sewing needle or 505 Temporary Spray Adhesive or safety pins (for basting the quilt), etc.
- Rotary cutter, mat, 6" x 24" and 12 1/2" square rulers
- Thread to match for piecing and binding, coordinating Aurifil or Rainbows thread for quilting
- Walking foot, 1/4" foot (Bernina #37), free motion foot (Bernina #9) optional
- Best Press Spray Starch
- Water soluble thread
- Notebook for class handouts
- Iron and ironing pad (optional)

Pre Class Preparation:

Important Notes:

- * Do not cut your batting and backing even with the top - it should be at minimum of 2" extra all round the quilt top. Instructions will be given in class #3 for squaring and binding your quilt.
- * Please cut your binding strips to a width of 2 1/4". This is a change in pattern cutting instructions

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and

we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



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- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.
