242. 2012 Block of the Month – Block 3

Mon., March 12 10 am – 12 noon or 6-8 pm

If you are still finding it a little difficult to complete the blocks for this year's Block of the Month class, please join us for this hands-on sewing session. Bring your sewing machine, general sewing supplies and Block of the Month Kit 3 to work on this block in class.

243. Basic Serger Class

Tues., March 13 10 am – 1 pm or 6-9 pm \$10.00 + Supplies

Still not feeling comfortable using the serger? Need to get it out of the box? Just want to make a super quick project? This is the class for you. We will be making a striped Table Runner and napkins so that you will be able to practice the 4 thread overlock, setting the serger for a rolled edge, perfecting the corner technique when making napkins, & setting the serger back to overlock. This class is for serger owners of any brand serger. Please know how to thread your serger before coming to class.
