

Materials We Accept

NEWSPAPER: needs to be clean and dry.

GLASS: any kind and color.

STEEL CANS: Rinsed out.

MAGAZINES

HDPE #2: Plastic, Opaque in color like milk and vinegar jugs. Need to be rinsed and the lids removed.

HDPE #2: Colored plastic (like laundry detergent bottles). Need to be rinsed and the lids removed.

PETE #1: Plastic pop, water, and most clear plastics. Need to be rinsed and lids removed.


MIXED PAPER/OFFICE PAPER: Junk mail, office waste, and any other recyclable paper.

CARDBOARD: Corrugated and pressed.

Each of these materials has it's own bin on the recycling trailer. Please help Greenwood County save time and tax dollars by placing them in the correct bins.
