**Preview Window:** It allows you to preview your movie as it currently is. You can use the play, pause, FF and RW buttons. The arrow near the bottom right corner of the image will allow you to preview in full screen mode.

**Tab:** Each tab produces different editing tools in the ribbon below. Click through to see your different options.

**Ribbon:** It has all the functions you will need to customize your movie.

**Storyboard:** The story board is a lineup of all the pictures and videos you have selected to put in your movie. The order they appear in the story board is the order it will appear in your movie. You can move these around with ease if you want them re ordered.

**Save Movie:** This is where you will find various saving options when you are totally finished editing your project. By using the "Save As" function you will still have a file you can edit. The file you create with this button you will no longer be able to edit.

**NOTE #1:** The small purple disk icon is where you want to save your project while editing. It is important to use this save button to be able to continue editing your project. When finished you will select a different way to save your project based on the type of video you want to create. Always take time to periodically save your project in case your computer malfunctions. By doing so you will not lose your entire project; only the unsaved portion.
