

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUT THE FOLLOWING PIECES:
SING 691 Y Panel square	1 panel	(5) 8 ½" blocks of your choice; centering the motif in the middle of each
SING 692 Y Rose border	1 ½ yards	(4) 5 $^{3}/_{4}$ " x 41" lengthwise strips; center the rose vine in the middle of each strip
SING 695 G Green dots	¹ /4 yard	(8) 2 ⁵ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (small pinwheels) (5) 4 ⁷ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 10 triangles (dogtooth border)
SING 695 B Blue dots	¹ /4 yard	(8) 2 5/8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (small pinwheels) (5) 4 7/8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 10 triangles (dogtooth border)
SING 695 P Pink dots	1 ½ yards	(2) ⁷ /8" x 28 ¹ /2" border strips (2) ⁷ /8" x 29 ¹ /4" border strips (2) ⁷ /8" x 39 ³ /4" strips (2) ⁷ /8" x 40 ¹ /2" strips (20) 1 ¹ /2" squares (sashing squares) (8) 2 ⁵ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (small pinwheels) (8) 2 ⁷ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (larger pinwheels) (5) 4 ⁷ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 10 triangles (dogtooth border) (5) 1 ¹ /2" x width-of-fabric (outer-border strips) (6) 2 ¹ /4" x width-of-fabric (binding strips)
SING 695 Y Yellow dots	¹ / ₄ yard	(8) 2 5/8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (small pinwheels) (5) 4 7/8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 10 triangles (dogtooth border)
White-on-white	1 ½ yards	(32) 2 ⁵ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 64 triangles (small pinwheels) (8) 2 ⁷ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 16 triangles (small pinwheels) (20) 4 ⁷ /8" squares; cut once diagonally to yield 10 triangles (dogtooth border) (16) 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4" (sashing strips) (24) 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 8 ¹ / ₂ " (sashing strips)
BACKING	3 ½ yards	Any Sing A Song fabric

Assembly

- 1. Using the 2 ⁵/8" pink triangles and white triangles, make (16) pink/white half-square triangles. In the same manner, make (16) blue/white half-square triangles, (16) green/white half-square triangles, and (16) yellow/light half-square triangles. The half-square triangles should all measure 2 ¹/4" square.
- 2. Lay out (4) pink/white half-square triangles as shown. Join the pieces to make a pinwheel block. The block should measure 4" square. Make (4) pink/white blocks. Repeat to make (4) yellow/white blocks, (4) blue/white blocks, and (4) green/white blocks.



3. Lay out one block of each color combination, (4) 1 ½ x 4 white sashing strips, and (1) 1 ½ pink square as shown. Sew the pieces into rows and then join the rows to complete the block. The block should measure 8 ½ square. Make (4) blocks.



- **4.** To make the block rows, lay out the Sing A Song blocks, the pinwheel blocks, and the $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ white sashing strips as shown in the photo. Join the pieces in each row, starting and ending with a sashing strip. Make (3) block rows.
- 5. To make the sashing rows, join (4) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " pink squares and (3) 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 8 $^{1}/_{2}$ " white sashing strips, starting and ending with a pink square. Make (4) sashing rows.
- **6.** Sew together the blocks rows and sashing rows as shown in the photo.
- 7. Sew the pink $28 \frac{1}{2}$ " long strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the pink $29 \frac{1}{4}$ " long strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- \mathcal{S} . Sew the Rose borders to the quilt top. Finish the corners with mitered seams.

- **9.** Sew the pink 39 $^{3}/_{4}$ " long strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the pink 40 $^{1}/_{2}$ " long strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 10. Using the 4 ⁷/₈" pink triangles and white triangles, make (10) pink/white half-square triangles. In the same manner, make (10) blue/white half-square triangles, (10) green/white half-square triangles, and (10) yellow/white half-square triangles. The half-square triangles should all measure 4 ¹/₂" square.
- 11. Referring to the photo for placement guidance, sew together (10) half-square triangles from step 10 to make a border strip, joining like-colored triangles to create larger triangles. Make (4) border strips.
- 12. Using the 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ pink triangles and white triangles, make (16) pink/white half-square triangles. The half-square triangles should measure 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ square.
- 13. Repeating step 2 and using the half-square triangles from step 12, make (4) pinwheel blocks. The blocks should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ square.
- 14. Join a border strip from step 11 to opposite sides of the quilt top as shown in the photo. Sew a pinwheel block from step 13 to both ends of each of the two remaining border strips and then sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 15. Join the 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " wide pink outer-border strips end to end. From the strip, cut (2) $48 ^{1}/_{2}$ " long strips and (2) $50 ^{1}/_{2}$ " long strips. Sew the shorter strips to the sides of the quilt top and then sew the longer strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 16. From the leftover green dots, make (16) $^{1}/_{2}$ " diameter circles. Appliqué the circles in the center of each sashing square, using the appliqué method you prefer.
- 17. Using the leftover blue dots, yellow dots, pink dots, and green dots, prepare and appliqué a 1" -diameter circle in the center of each pair of half-square triangles in the outer border. Refer to the photo as needed.
- **18.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired and bind the edges to finish.
