

THE ROMAN CROSS

10.5" X 10.5" (finished)

All instructions are written for rotary cutting.



(Refer to diagram for placement)

- A. (Tips of cross)
Cut two squares 2-1/4". Sub cut each diagonally to make 4 diamonds.
- B. Background fabric - cut 3 squares 3-7/8" - Sub cut diagonally both directions producing 12 diamonds.
- C. Striped rectangles - Cut one strip 25". Sub cut 4 rectangles 6-1/8" X 2-3/8".
- D. Background - Cut 4 squares 2-3/8" X 2-3/8"
Cross - Cut 8 squares 2-3/8" X 2-3/8"
Accent square - Cut 1 square 2-3/8" X 2-3/8"

Sewing the block:

1. Sew together the center 9-patch squares. Press.
2. Sew each triangle A to square D.
3. Sew one background triangle B to each side of pieced section you just made. Press.
4. Sew two of these corner sections to rectangle C. Press
5. Sew one section to each side of 9-patch unit sewn previously. Press.
6. Sew one background triangle to each side of remaining rectangles. Press
7. Sew remaining pieced corners to one side of rectangle unit.
8. Sew these pieced corner units to each side of central section to complete your block.
Press well and trim to 10.5" square.
