KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Dr. Peter Sorensen

A professor at the University of Minnesota since 1988, Dr. Peter Sorensen has been at the forefront of carp removal/control research for the past several years, focusing on common carp, their impacts and methods of control. He has collaborated with researchers from around the world while assisting in carp control programs in Australia and New Zealand. His approach to carp control has resulted in unprecedented progress towards removal of carp in two Minnesota lakes.

Dr. Przemek Bajer

Dr. Przemek Bajer, a research associate at the University of Minnesota, has been working on carp control with Dr. Sorensen since 2006. He has published 84 journal articles on fish and fish behavior, including ground breaking work on the impacts of common carp, carp population structure and carp control methods. In addition, he has established carp population threshold for population size and loss of aquatic vegetation. His work with radio tagged carp has contributed to successful carp reduction programs in Minnesota.
