


The BERNINA 830 Threading the Bobbin Hook System for Embroidery

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
Threading the hook system for embroidery



- 1. Insert bobbin and slide thread into the slit
- 2. Rest thread on finger and take it towards the thread cutter




3. Bring the thread forward to the metal curve and to the highest point of the curve




4. Let the thread slide down the metal piece (retaining wall)


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
5. As you near the end of the retaining wall, you will feel a click and the thread has slid into the extra tensioner (slot) needed for embroidery.



This is the slot the thread is going into. There is a mirror that came with the 830 to see this. Once you know the motion, the mirror is not necessary

- 6. Once the thread is in the slot, it will not come out
- 7. Take the thread to the cutter and it is ready to embroider.

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
