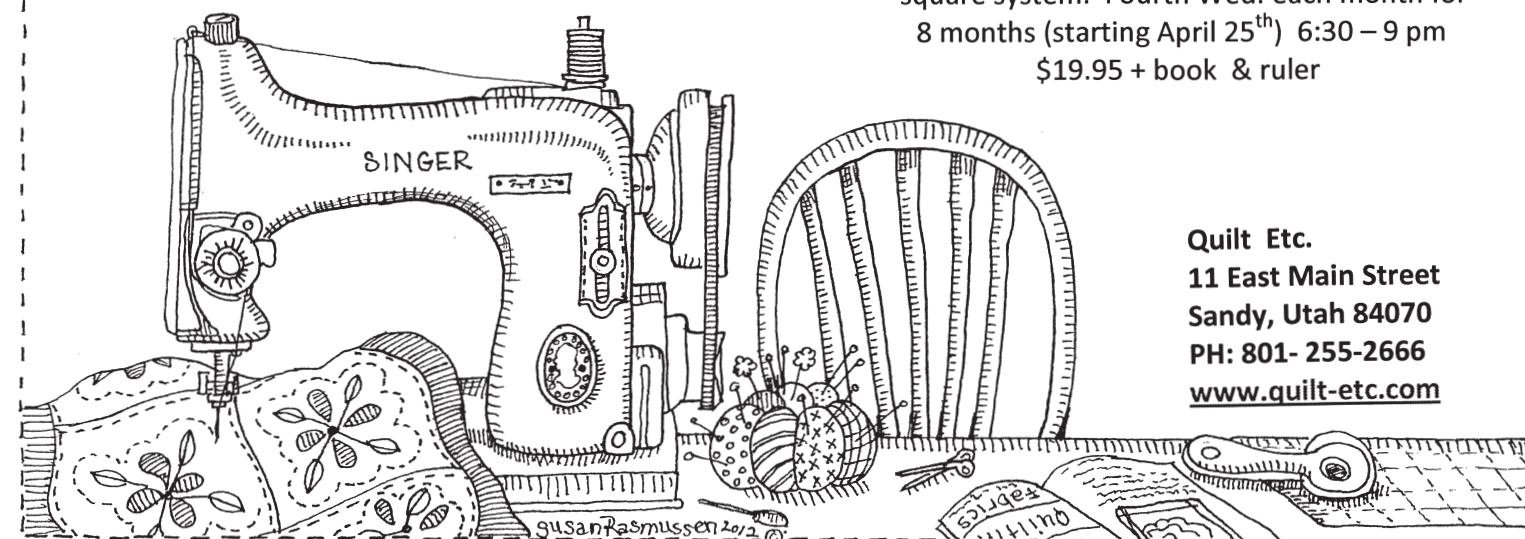
Knit Wits - Ellen Grundvig

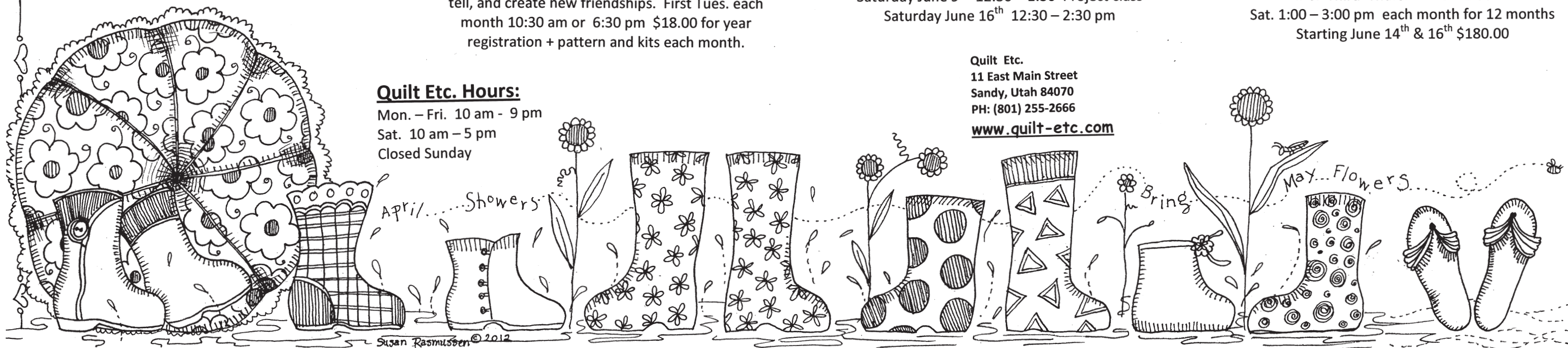
Simple Things Quilt - Jeana Kimball
