



Fabrics Required:

1 3/4 yd light fabric A 1 7/8 yd medium fabric B 1/2 yd dark fabric *C*



1 1/3 yd border fabric5/8 yd binding fabric3 7/8 yd backing fabric piece horizontally




Cutting Instructions:

From the light fabric A cut:

Two 5 1/4" strips; subcut into (10) 5 1/4" squares cut diagonally twice Five 4 7/8" strips; subcut into (40) 4 7/8" squares cut diagonally once Five 4 1/2" strips; subcut into (20) 4 1/2" squares







Two 1" strips; subcut into (80) 1" squares From the medium fabric B cut:

Five 4 7/8" strips; subcut into (40) 4 7/8" squares cut diagonally once

Five 4 1/2" strips; subcut into (40) 4 1/2" squares

Four 2 7/8" strips; subcut into (40) 2 7/8" squares cut diagonally once

Two 2" strips; subcut into (40) 2" squares

From the dark fabric C cut:

Three 5 1/4" strips; subcut into (20) 5 1/4" squares cut diagonally twice

From the outer border fabric cut:

Seven 6 1/2" strips; piece together and subcut into four 6 1/2" \times 60 1/2" borders From the binding fabric cut:

Seven 2 1/2" strips; piece together to make one long strip

Assemble the Block:

1. Sew a 4 7/8" fabric A triangle to a 4 7/8" fabric B triangle as shown. Make 80.

2. Sew a 1" fabric C square to a 2 7/8" fabric B triangle as shown. Trim seam and press. Make 80. Sew two units together and press seam open. Make 40.









3. Sew the 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " fabric A & fabric C triangles together. Make 40. Sew a 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " fabric C triangle to a step 2 unit. Make 40. Sew together as shown. Make 40.












4. Sew four 2" fabric B squares diagonally to the four corners of a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric A square. Trim corners and press. Make 10.










5. Assemble the block as shown. Make 10









6. Sew the remaining $4\frac{1}{2}$ " step 1 squares together with the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric A & B squares as shown. Make 10.







Assemble the Quilt:

- 1. Sew alternating blocks in five rows of four blocks.
- 2. Sew two 6 $1/2" \times 60 \ 1/2"$ borders to the two sides then to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 3. Layer the quilt back right side down, the batting, and the quilt top. Quilt as desired. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top. Stitch the binding, raw edges even to the quilt. Turn to the back and slipstitch.
