Beginning English Smocking by Hand...

Do you admire the look of smocked clothes and home décor? This is an easy to learn fabric manipulation technique. You will learn the basic stitches of English Smocking while creating a 12 row sampler. The finished sampler can be incorporated into a purse, apron, pillow or girls dress. Once you have learned the basic stitches, new stitches and styles of smocking will be easily within your reach.

Never stitched by hand? The beginning stitcher is welcome... no previous hand stitching experience is required.

Your class kit includes:

Beginning English Smocking Guidelines, Prepleated ivory or white fabric insert, four skeins DMC stranded embroidery floss, #7 crewel and/or darner hand needle(s)

Upon Sign Up: (1.) Choose four colors of floss for stitching the design. One of these colors should be a green appropriate for leaves and one or more colors chosen for flowers. (2.) Specify white or ivory insert color. (3.) Please specify right or left handed stitching directions.

Please bring to class – small scissors for clipping threads, needle threader Not required by very helpful – personal task lighting/magnification, Thread Heaven thread conditioner


