4. <u>Site Plan: Colledge Machine – 445 North 1030 West</u>

(45 minutes)

This is a request by Joe Colledge for approval of a site plan for a new steel office/warehouse facility located in the Light Industrial (LI) zone. The applicant is proposing to construct an 8,750 sq/ft building that would be used in conjunction with the existing adjacent 'Lindon Collision' auto repair business. Mr. Colledge's plan show a steel building with a wainscot, off-street parking, ADA parking, dumpster enclosure, asphalt driveway, and a off-site detention basin.

5. <u>Conditional Use Permit: SkinScience Institute – 135 South State Street</u>

(20 minutes)

This is a request by Candice Caudle for approval of a conditional use permit for a cosmetic institute located in the General Commercial (CG) zone. Currently, the Lindon City Standard Land Use Table requires any professional/vocational schools located in the CG zone to acquire a conditional use permit. The applicant is proposing a masters esthetics program/institute that would be an extension to their Salt Lake campus to accommodate students in Utah County.

6. Public Hearing: Ordinance changes to LCC Section 17.04.290-17.04.310 Clear Vision & Fencing

(25 minutes

This is a City initiated ordinance change to the 'Clear Vision' and 'Fencing' sections of the Lindon City Code. These changes were originally advertised to be reviewed at the January 28th, 2009 Planning Commission meeting, but was postponed to this meeting. Recommendations from the Planning Commission will be made to the City Council for final approval.

7. Public Hearing: Ordinance changes to LCC Section 17.44 Single-Family Residential

(25 minutes)

This is a City initiated ordinance change to the 'Single-Family Residential' section of the Lindon City Code. These changes were originally advertised to be reviewed at the January 28th, 2009 Planning Commission meeting, but was postponed to this meeting. Recommendations from the Planning Commission will be made to the City Council for final approval.

- 8. Public Hearing: Ordinance addition LCC Sections 17.33 Plat Amendment & 17.34 Property Line Adjustment (15 minutes)

 This is a City initiated ordinance addition to include requirements for 'Plan Amendments' and 'Property Line Adjustments'. These additions to the Lindon City Code were originally advertised to be reviewed at the January 28th, 2009 Planning Commission meeting, but was postponed to this meeting. This is intended to only be a draft/revision item, staff feels that the item should be continued to the March 11th, 2009 Planning Commission meeting for approval.
- 9. Public Hearing: Ordinance changes to LCC Section 17.32 Subdivision & 17.38 Bonding

(15 minutes)

This is a City initiated ordinance change to the 'Subdivision' and 'Bonding' section of the Lindon City Code. These changes were advertised for this meeting. This is intended to only be a draft/revision item, staff feels that the item should be continued to the March 11th, 2009 Planning Commission meeting for approval.
