## LANDSCAPING REQUIREMENTS

## Principle landscaping standards:



- Landscaped strip, twenty (20') in width.
a. Landscaped berm at least ( $3^{\prime}$ ) high in the R\&B, CG, PC-1, PC-2, \& MC zones (LI \& HI require no berm).
b. Planted with grass and maintained in a living, growing condition along all public street frontages.
c. $30 \%$ of the landscaping strip may consist of decorative rock, bark, mulch, and/or other ground covers other than grass.
d. Trees planted $30^{\prime}$ on center, centered $10^{\prime}$ from the edges of the strip.
e. Recommended trees found in the Lindon City Tree Planting Guide and required to be:
i. At least 2 " in caliper, measured 1 ' above ground; and
ii. shall be at least $6^{\prime}$ in height when planted
f. Plants shall be serviced by an acceptable underground automatic irrigation or sprinkler system.

* 3' berm and 2-rail fence only required in certain zones.
- Interior parking lot landscaping in the R\&B, CG, PC-1, PC-2, \& MC zones (LI \& HI require none); see Lindon City Code Section 17.18.085.
- Concrete curbing shall be provided between landscaped areas and offstreet parking areas, at lease 6 " higher than parking area.
- All required landscaping that abuts frontage on a dedicated street in the CG, PC-1, and PC-2 zones shall contain a continuous 3 ' white vinyl ranch style two rail fence.
- Minimum of each lot shall be maintained in permanent landscaped open space. (R\&B - 30\%; CG, PC-1 \& PC-2 -20\%; MC - 15\%; and LI \& HI - none).
- All lots with freeway frontage (if not in conflicts with utilities or other infrastructure) require a landscape strip with a 10 minimum width running the length of frontage along I-15.
a. Trees shall be planted $30^{\prime}$ on center.
- $\mathrm{R} \& B$ zone, a perimeter landscape strip at least $5^{\prime}$ wide shall be placed around all buildings.
- See individual ordinance standards for each zone for specific landscaping requirements.
