

STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN REQUIREMENTS

1. Purpose of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan

The purpose of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan is to control storm water runoff and reduce pollutants in storm water runoff during construction by accomplishing the following:

- A. Controlling soil erosion
- B. Controlling discharge of sediment into storm drainage facilities or off-site
- C. Prevent illicit discharges into on-site soils, into storm drainage facilities or off-site
- D. Prevent uncontrolled discharge of storm water to adjacent property
- E. Controlling construction waste
- F. Controlling dust

2. Contents of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan

The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan is to be submitted with the site plans or improvement plans. It shall contain the items included in the SWPPP Preconstruction Submittal and Review Checklist. This checklist shall be completed by the applicant and submitted with the SWPPP.

If there are lots within the area that are subject to the Hillside Protection Zone (as defined in Section 17.57.220 of the Lindon City Code), the plan also must meet the requirements of Sections 17.57.100 and 17.57.120 of the Lindon City Code.
