### VINEYARD CONNECTOR PIPELINE UPDATE

The first piece of pipe on the Vineyard Segment of the CWP North Shore Aqueduct was installed the week of Monday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. While this construction should have minimal impact on traffic over the next few weeks it will affect traffic toward the middle of July when pipeline construction crosses 200 South near 2000 West, Lindon. This portion of the project should be completed no later than July 31<sup>st</sup>. Please be aware that 200 South, Lindon will be closed during the crossing for approximately seven days and will affect access to the North Pointe Solid Waste Transfer Station (Landfill).
