

She is experienced in appraising both antique and new quilts. Each typed appraisal includes a detailed description, history, and photo of the quilt, and its value. Appraisals are \$45.00 per quilt and take 30 minutes per quilt, are sent to the quilt owner within 2 weeks after your appointment. Written appraisals are sent to the owner within 2 weeks of the appointment and provide proof of the quilt's value for insurance purposes. Kathy also provides good information regarding the care and repair of quilts. Don't miss this opportunity to have your quilts appraised!


#### FIRST SATURDAY
