Photo Transfer Workshop by Linda Bratten April 11th 10-2 \$35

You have seen the samples around the shop; now take the time to learn how to turn your own photos into works of art! Once you learn how easy this technique is you'll be making wall hangings and quilts that document major events in your life.

This workshop is designed to show you how to transfer your photos to printable fabrics, how to do some basic editing, enlarge the photo to a poster size, and put together a basic wall hanging. We will also consider various thread painting and quilting options that are available to enhance your photo transfers.

We will use a photo of a rose that I took at the Botanical Gardens in St. Louis, MO for our workshop project.
