- 2. Keep your design quiet and anonymous. The only one who is to know who has made each design until after the judging is Susan Hyder. She is not judging, but putting numbers on each design so the judges can judge each one. We do not want the judges to know who made each design ahead of time so they can be totally impartial.
- 3. Send in your design on a standard  $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ " paper. We will need to copy them so the judges can have a copy. When you send in the design, include on separate piece of paper your name and contact info. You can hand deliver them, e-mail, or USPS them in. Designs will be accepted from now until March  $31^{st}$ . Judging will begin on April  $1^{st}$  with the judges having one week to judge.
- 4. All who enter will receive a gift for participating. The top three entries will receive a prize with first prize being an Amy Bradley Design Tee Shirt of their choosing. Second and third prize are yet to be determined.
- 5. All entries will be ranked individually in order by each judge. The judges will be given entries with a designator on each one. The judges will then rank the entries in order, with one being the best in their opinion on down to however many entries there are. Judges are not going to talk with each other in deciding their order. The votes will then be tallied and the top three will be picked.
